Medals, more medals, and the Wine Spectator?

This past year Tularosa Vineyards garnered 6 medals for our wines entered in recent competitions. Which include a silver medal for our 2000 Cabernet Sauvignon, a bronze medal for our 2001 Symphony and another bronze medal for our 2001 Tempranillo at the New Mexico State Fair. We also came away with 3 bronze medals for our 2001 Sangiovese, 2001 Tempranillo and 2001 Shiraz at the Southwest Wine Competition. As if that were not enough good news. We also recieved some wines that made the pages of the Wine Spectator. With the 2000 Gewürztraminer garnering the highest score of any New Mexico wines with an 84. In addition, we also recieved an 81 for our 2001 Sangiovese and an 80 for our 2001 Shiraz in more recent issues. Keep an eye out in the future as our Tularosa Basin vineyards mature the wine is sure to get even better.

Winery Expansion

This winter Tularosa Vineyards is undergoing an expansion in the tank room area of the winery. The roof is literally being raised higher so that much larger (1000 gallon+) tanks can be retrofitted. This expansion will help us keep up with the growing demand for Tularosa Vineyards wines as well as process more of the grapes becoming available in the local area.
